I. Main Sermon: John 4:43-54

A. Jesus' Return to Galilee

- **John 4:43-45:** Jesus heads to Galilee after staying with Samaritans for two days.
- **Cultural Context:** Jews typically avoided prolonged contact with Samaritans.

- **Encouragement for Believers:** Trust in Jesus' mercy and power, even when faith is weak
