I. Introduction

- **Passage:** John 6:22-35
- **Context:** After feeding the 5,000, Jesus confronts the crowd about their motives for following Him.

II. Key Themes and Discussions

A. Seeking Temporary vs. Eternal Satisfaction

- **Crowd's Focus:** The people seek Jesus for more physical bread, failing to understand His deeper message.
- **Jesus' Response:** Jesus encourages them to pursue the "food that endures to eternal life" (John 6:27), which He alone can give.
