

Sermon Notes

I. Introduction

- **Passage: Acts 20:17-35**
- **Context: Paul's farewell address to the Ephesian elders as he prepares to face imprisonment in Jerusalem.**

II. Key Themes and Discussions

A. Paul's Life and Ministry

- **Integrity in Ministry: Paul reminds the elders that he served the Lord with humility, tears, and trials (Acts 20:19), faithfully proclaiming the Gospel.**
- **Whole Counsel of God: Paul emphasizes that he has declared the full counsel of God and is innocent of any responsibility for those who reject the truth (Acts 20:26-27).**

B. Warning of Wolves in the Church

- **Savage Wolves: Paul warns that after his departure, false teachers will come in, seeking to distort the truth and lead believers astray (Acts 20:29).**
- **Internal Dangers: Some of these wolves will arise from within the church, speaking perverse things to draw disciples after themselves (Acts 20:30).**

C. Truth in Jesus Christ

- **Truth is a Person: Pastor Wes emphasizes that truth is not a formula but the person of Jesus Christ, who is "the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6).**
- **Staying Rooted in Scripture: Believers are urged to remain grounded in the full counsel of God's Word and to rely on the Holy Spirit to discern truth from falsehood.**

III. Conclusion

- **Vigilance Against Falsehood: Pastor Wes calls the church to be vigilant against false teachers, knowing that the Holy Spirit will guide them into all truth (John 16:13).**
- **Encouragement: Trust in Jesus as the embodiment of truth and stay rooted in His Word to avoid deception.**
